




Chlamydia Notifications April 2016 – March 2017




Gonorrhoea notifications April 2016 – March 2017



HIV notifications April 2016 – March 2017


➤ Majority of HIV notifications occurred in age groups 30 and above 70%, under the age of 30 years old accounted for 30% of HIV notifications




